11.15am: Short Service tailored for the lunch club and others who would like to join us.




### **Information Sheet**

Greetings from Christ Church, Cotmanhay and Shipley. We are a worshipping community and hope that this leaflet will provide you with some information about who we are as a church and what we do. Please contact us if you would like any more information.

### **Who are we?**

Christ Church Cotmanhay and Shipley is part of South East Derbyshire Deanery and the Diocese of Derby in the Church of England.

### **Do you know anyone who would welcome the Church praying for them?**

We pray for individuals asking for prayer. There is a book for prayer requests at church and people are happy to pray with you following the 10am service.

### **Does the Church give money to charity?**

The Church gives 10% of its income to support local, national and overseas charities.

### **Does the Church have a choir?**

Yes, the church has a small choir that sings at 10am services.

### **What work does the Church do with the youth?**

The Church hosts a number of Uniformed Organisations including Rainbows, Brownies, Guides, Senior Section, Cubs, Beavers and Scouts. These are represented at a monthly Parade service. The Church runs a monthly Sunday Club during the 10am service. We have links with local schools, contributing to assemblies at local primary schools and providing services on special occasions.

### **Does the Church welcome very young children and babies?**

Yes, we are always happy to see young families and hold regular services with Thanksgiving or Baptism (Christening). There is an activity table in the corner of church.

### **Is there a parent/carer and toddler group?**

Yes, Daisy Chain meets on Tuesday mornings (9.15 till 11.15) and afternoons (1 till 3) during term time. There is also a Friday 'time out' coffee break (9.15 till 11 in

term time) for parents and carers to relax while the children play together.

### **Do you have a Church Hall that can be hired?**

Yes, we have an excellent facility that can be hired out and plays host to a variety of regular events.

### **How does the Church serve the local community?**

This takes many forms including through hosting a lunch club, delivering Christmas hampers and supplying 'The King's Pantry' with food for those in need in our community.

### **Does the Church organise social activities?**

Yes, a number of events and activities are arranged throughout the year. We have, for example, Summer and Christmas Fayres; Harvest Supper and Auction; Coffee Morning each Tuesday during term time (10.15 till 11.45); and a group of members attends the "Transform Weekend" Christian conference.

### **Are there small groups that can be joined?**

Yes, various small groups for study, prayer and finding out more about the Christian Faith are held throughout the year.
